## III. PLEASE FURNISH A RESOLUTION FROM THE FOREIGN CREDIT UNION'S BOARD ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Loans originated in North Carolina will comply with Chapters 54 and 24 of the North Carolina General Statutes
- 2. Applicable North Carolina laws, rules, and regulations will be followed
- 3. Copies of regulatory examination reports, and other documents or reports will be furnished at the request of the Administrator of Credit Unions in North Carolina
- 4. Submit to an examination if deemed necessary by the Administrator of Credit Unions in North Carolina
- 5. Designate and maintain with the North Carolina Credit Union Division a North Carolina registered agent for service of process

The conditions under which a foreign credit union may conduct business in North Carolina are set forth in North Carolina General Statutes § 54-109.106 (2024).
